OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES

SNOWSHOEING

Head to Roberts Farm Preserve for over 7 miles of multi-use, groomed trails. All snowshoes, skis, etc. are free to use during your visit! Get some exercise and try something new without the pressure to buy equipment.

DOWNHILL SKIING

Mt Abram Ski Mountain (30 Mins)

- family friendly, small

Lost Valley (30 Mins)

- family friendly, small, brewpub on site

Sunday River (40 Mins)

- large, extensive trail system

ORDWAY GROVE TRAIL

This 10-acre trail connects downtown to beautiful Penneesseewassee Lake. Grab your boots and pursue this half-mile loop trail that showcases some of the oldest eastern white pine trees in the entire state (some 315 years old!)

SLEDDING & ART

Head to Shepard's Farm for the best sledding hills near Norway! Also, look for six tall sculptures made by Maine artist, Bernard Langlais that have been installed in the 20 acre parcel of land.





OUTSIDE THE BOX

experiences not to miss

RIVERSIDE LODGE & SAUNA

Book a private wood fired sauna just five minutes up the road in Paris, Maine! After your session wraps, treat yourself to a massage, facial or bite to eat from their dining room.

GOAT HIKES AT TEN APPLE FARM

A two hour experience that consists of a one and a half mile loop through the woods on lightly groomed trails. Play with goats, learn about the farm - great for kids over age five! Just under 40 minutes away.

ROCKHOUND AT MOUNT APATITE

If there's no snow on the ground, bundle up and head to this trail system that leads to a quarry filled with tourmaline & quartz that you are welcome to bring home!

FIND THE BEER HUT AT OXBOW

Oxbow Brewing Company (10 mins away) has nordic trail systems + cross country ski rentals. Along the trail, find the beer hut nestled deep in the woods for a cold one! After, enjoy pizza & more beer in their toasty barn or by firepit.
